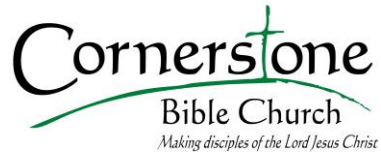

Cornerstone Bible Church Membership Covenant

Having received Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior, and being in agreement with CBC's vision, doctrine, and distinctives, I now desire to become a member of the CBC church family. In doing so, I commit myself to God and the other members of this church to do the following:

PURSUING:

I will pursue God through consistent study of His Word and prayer. I will strive to live a holy life by the grace of God and in accordance with the Word of God. I will endeavor to be a godly example to all people in speech, behavior, and attitude. (2 Timothy 2:15; 1 Thess. 5:17; Titus 2:12)

FOLLOWING:

I will pray for, communicate with, honor, and submit to my church elders, as long as they are functioning in a Biblical manner in their role as shepherds. I will do my best to make their ministry a joy and not a grief for them. (Heb. 13:17)

ASSIMILATING:

I will purpose to stay involved in the body life of CBC. I will faithfully attend Worship Services and other church functions in order that I might give and receive the benefits of Christian fellowship. (Heb. 10:24-25)

SHEPHERDING:



I will do my best to make CBC a friendly, nurturing church both to members and visitors. I will pray for the other members and ministries of the church. I will ungrudgingly extend practical acts of service and kindness to others within the church family. (Gal. 6:10)

WITNESSING:

I will seek to win the lost for the Lord Jesus Christ by living and verbalizing the truth of the gospel. I will support the missionary enterprise of CBC. (Acts 1:8; Mark 16:15)

PROTECTING:

I will be diligent to protect the unity of CBC by acting in love toward all other members, by refraining from gossip, and by my attitude of deference in non-essential matters. I will protect the reputation of CBC before the world by living a holy, authentic life. (John 13:34-35; Prov. 20:19; Rom. 14:1-13; Rom. 12:9-10)

GIVING:

I will give Biblically according to my means to support the work of CBC. (1 Cor. 16:2; 2 Cor. 9:6-9; Gal. 6:6)

LEAVING:

In the event that I choose to leave CBC, I will inform the elders of my plans to leave the congregation, and I will do so in a way that will bring honor to Christ. I will seek to involve myself in another Biblical congregation upon my departure from CBC. (1 Cor. 10:31)
