

HFG Questions for
“Revealing Grace to You”
 (2 Corinthians 4:15)

Read 2 Corinthians 4:15

1. Before the message this past Sunday, did you find yourself as one of those who tend to only focus on the definition of grace being “unmerited favor”? If yes, why do you think we tend to do that?

2. In the last stanza of Amazing Grace, “When we’ve been there ten thousand years, Bright shining as the sun, We’ve no less days to sing God’s praise Than when we’d first begun.” What is one of the very things we will be doing in Heaven? Can you think of any Scripture verses that describe how we should be living right now in light of that coming day?

3. Read Eph. 2:8-9 – How are people saved? Do good works save us? What role does good works play in the Christian life? (ref: Titus 1:16)

4. In 2 Peter 3:18 we are given a command; what is that command and how can we live it out?

5. What were the two kinds of grace described in last Sunday’s message? Read Psalm 145:9, Lam. 3:22-23 and Romans 8:29-30; which types of grace do these verses imply?

6. Read Romans 3:10-18 & Ecc. 7:20. Who deserves grace?

7. While some examples of Bible characters were given, can you think of other Bible characters who were an example of God’s grace in their lives, or can you give an example of God’s grace in your life?

8. Since we are under grace, and literally standing and engulfed in it – is it ok to keep on in our sins? Read Romans 6:1-2.

Application: Can you think of one person who doesn’t deserve any good thing from you. Are you praying for them regularly? How can you show God’s Amazing Grace to them?
