“Sound Doctrine & Sensible Living”

(Titus 2:1-10)

READ:

1) Today, Pastor Cary is preaching about how your parents should act. The Bible says a lot about your parents, and it also says a lot about YOU! The book in the Bible called “Ephesians” says this: “Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Honor your father and mother...”.

2) When you obey your parents and honor them, you are obeying and honoring God! God cares A LOT about how you treat your parents. This is because your parents are an example of who God is! If you disobey your parents, then you are disobeying God. If you respect and honor your mom and dad, then you honor God.

4) When you grow up, you will see that learning to honor your parents has taught you to honor God! God expects you to fear Him and obey Him all the time. This will be easy for you if you practice obeying your parents right now. The Bible also says that if you obey your parents, it will go well with you. This means that God loves to bless the kids who humbly obey their parents.

5) What if your parents are not nice to you, or say things that you do not like? God still tells you to obey your mom and dad. He will keep you safe and help you, if you trust in Him. God wants you to pray to Him, telling Him all your thoughts. God promises to take care of you if you ask Him to. Trust in the love of God!

6) Sometimes, it seems like we cannot please God or please our parents. This is because you and I sin A LOT! If you ask God to forgive your sin, He will forgive you! If you ask God to help you obey your parents, He will help you! Your parents want to help you too.
